Prestbury School PTA Fundraising for 2022/2023

Fundraising Goal: £10,000

This year we have agreed to contribute PTA funds towards a larger scale ongoing project within school, and smaller pots of money for individual year groups to choose items to invest in which will enhance the children's curriculum and school experience. We have also committed to contributing a percentage of PTA funds raised to the school charity of the year.

In consultation with Mr Capener and the teaching staff, we have agreed to try and raise funds this year to pay for the following items.

Whole School: Outdoor Classroom Gathering Garden



The next phase of the school outdoor learning classroom is the space directly outside of it. The area intends to be developed so that classes can use the space for outdoor lessons, with the potential for use at lunchtime too. PTA funds this year will contribute towards the landscaping of this area: re-surfacing and installation of an outdoor seating area which will be used for lessons. Please note, at this time, the fire pit is not being installed.

Reception Classes: Rugged Robot and Tactile Code Reader:



A Rugged Robot is a programmable robot that can be used outdoors as well as inside. It can travel through mud and water, as well as across different surfaces. It is a larger and sturdier version of the Bee-Bots we currently use.



To accompany this is a TacTile code reader that

allows the children to program instructions onto a tile reader and then watch the robot complete the program. Individual tiles can be changed, and the sequence of instructions developed.

It helps us to teach the early stages of coding in a fun and meaningful way. The children can set up their own obstacle courses to manoeuvre the robot round and identify any errors or changes they want to make.
